Non-US Citizen — Relocating to the US

Customs Paperwork

In order to ship your vehicle in the most expedient manner, we require proper documentation for US Customs. We prefer that you return all documents via overnight courier (you should keep and make copies). If you choose to fax us copies, they must be very clear.

3299 Form - Declaration for Free Entry of Unaccompanied articles

This is the most important document for Customs purposes and must be carefully completed. Fill in boxes 1-7 in Part I; and box 9B in Part II. On the second page, add the year, make, model and complete 17-digit VIN under Column 2, Description of Merchandise. Under Column 3, Value or Cost of Repairs, put in the amount that you value your vehicle at. In Part VI, sign and date this document.

Compliance Letter (Not required for a US-titled vehicle)

You must obtain a compliance letter from your vehicle manufacturer. We can provide phone numbers if necessary. If the vehicle is non-compliant, there are often exceptions allowed. Please sign the HS-7 and EPA forms in case these are required for minor compliance issues (also not required for US-titled vehicle).

Copy of stamped 1-94 or equivalent

This is the Visa part of your passport to be stamped by US Customs, and is proof that you are allowed to be in the US. An equivalent might be a work visa, diplomatic posting or military posting letter.

Copy of Passport or Equivalent

Either a copy of the photo page of your passport OR your driver's license, plus birth certificate, is required. Please make a very clear copy using a picture or other appropriate setting. The quality of a document declines when faxed, so make sure that you start with the best possible quality.

Copy of vehicle ownership

A copy of the vehicle ownership is necessary. Please make a light, but readable copy, as fax transmissions can result in documents that are too dark to read.

Letter

This is very important for our driver when presenting the paperwork to US Customs. A simple paragraph stating the reason for moving the vehicle should be part of the letter. A letter from your employer is also useful.

Proof of Purchase/Bill of Sale-Not Mandatory but good idea to include

A copy of your original bill of sale or title for the state where the vehicle was registered is required to show that the vehicle was purchased in the USA.

Copy of Passport or Equivalent

Either a copy of the photo page of your passport OR your photo driver's license plus birth certificate is required. Please make a very clear copy using a picture or other appropriate setting. The quality of a document declines when faxed, so make sure that you start the best possible quality.

Copy of Vehicle title or registration

A copy of the vehicle title is necessary. Please make a light but readable copy, as fax transmission can result in documents that are too dark to read.

Letter

This is very important for our driver when presenting the paperwork to US customs. A simple letter stating the reason for moving the vehicle should be part of the letter. A letter from your employer is also useful.

Personal Belongings.

Your vehicle must be empty of personal belongings, as they are not insured, and create a problem for the driver and a challenge with both US and Canadian Customs.
