

Documentation Required for Entering Puerto Rico

For vehicles entering Puerto Rico, the following legible documents will be required from shipper:

- 1. Registration;**
- 2. Vehicle Title or letter from the bank authorizing shipment;**
- 3. Photo ID of owner;**
- 4. Copy of Social Security card or any other official document with the number on it. (This number is used as shipper's file number at the tax office)**

Vehicles entering Puerto Rico will go through the process of clearance with the local authorities, and these documents will give our agent the authorization to remove the vehicle from the port and deliver it to our agent's facility. Once the vehicle arrives at our agent's facility, the vehicle will be appraised by the local tax inspector for tax clearance. Every vehicle coming into the island is due to pay importation taxes, with the exception of privately-owned vehicles of active duty military members, federal employees with transportation agreement, and re-imported vehicles. Once the taxes or exemption on taxes has been completed, the vehicle is available for delivery or pick up.
